


2008: The first hoarding takes shape at Dublin

2011: The new Terminal 2 building is unveiled

This 5-year, **two-part project** is a sustainability exemplar project because the majority of the **Kwik-Klik** *Ultraspan* panels now installed at the ITV Granada Studios site in Salford Quays were previously used for over 3 years at the site of Dublin Airport's Terminal 2 building.

Over 1.5 linear kilometres of hoarding panels were needed to establish a secure perimeter around the construction site of Dublin's Terminal 2 from January 2008. When the Dublin project was complete in the summer of 2011, the hoardings were dismantled and 810 linear metres was transported to Salford Quays to create the site perimeter for the new ITV Granada Studios development at MediaCityUK.




